Registration: Students may pre-register in room 204 at Bastrop High School from May 4 – June 9. Main registration sessions will be held in the Bastrop High School cafeteria on the following dates:

- Wednesday, June 10 from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- Thursday, June 11 from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- Saturday, June 13 from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Late registration will take place on the following date:

- Monday, June 15 from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. in the BHS cafeteria.

There is an additional \$25 charge for students registering during the late registration process.

Student Eligibility: Current BHS students wanting to gain credit for core content course failed.
Current BHS students wanting to earn 1st time course credit for acceleration.
Current BHS students who failed Exit Level ELA, Science, Social studies and/or Math TAKS.
Out of district students will not be accepted.

Tuition is due at the time of registration.

Credit: Students may take up to two recovery courses. Students may earn 1 credit during the session per recovery course. Students may take one acceleration course during the session. Students may earn ½ a credit during the session for acceleration courses.

Absences: Students are allowed two (2) absences. Students will be dismissed upon the third (3rd) absence and will not receive credit for the course. No exceptions. Three (3) tardies equal one absence.

Campus Rules: The student code of conduct will be extended to cover summer school students. Students will receive a warning for the first disciplinary infraction. On the second disciplinary infraction, students will receive a one day suspension. Students will be removed from summer school and tuition forfeited for the third disciplinary infraction.

Refunds: Refunds will not be made if students are removed from summer school due to absences, tardies, and/or discipline issues.
