### **2005 Bond Proposition...**

Renovations & additions will allow BHS Main Campus to house approximately	2100 students
Renovations & additions will temporarily allow West Campus to house approximately	900 students

...however, *West Campus is swing space* and is eventually scheduled to be re-tooled for other instructional purposes.

**Current Renovations and Additions** to BHS were also requested in previous bond elections...renovations and additions to BHS and West campus were planned as phase **1 of a 2 phase planning process** which includes a 2nd High School.

High School **Enrollment exceeded the planning benchmarks in 2005** with an enrollment of 2200 + students.

### **2007 Bond Proposition for Cedar Creek High School**

Cedar Creek High School, to be located at Pope Bend & SH 71, will be constructed to house 1500 students, with a core infrastructure that can support 2300. Future classroom additions will occur as growth projections support the need for capital improvement investment. When construction on the 2nd HS is complete, total district High School enrollment will land somewhere around 2542 (see 2008 Demographic Study). At this time, BISD is conservatively projected total district-wide, High School enrollment to reach 3,000 students by 2017.
