Student Services

- Registered nurses are staffed full-time at each of the eight regular program campuses to provide health services to all BISD students.
- Academic and special education counselors offer counseling services at each of the ten campuses.
- District wide, 3500 students are eligible to ride one of the district's 58 bus routes. The transportation system covers approximately 6200 miles daily.
- Nutritionally balanced breakfasts and lunches are offered at each campus along with fast food service at the secondary schools. The district participates in the National School Lunch Program, which affords free and reduced-price meals based on a student's financial needs.

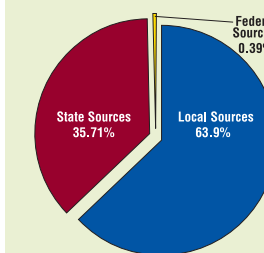
